Now let's take a walk from Pier 1 to Pier 6. Piers 2 -5 are currently under construction. The park is expecting all the construction to be done in 2 – 3 year's time. As you walk from Pier 1 to Pier 6, take note of all the different type of construction going on. Are you excited to see what will be there when it's done?

Pier 6

1. **One Brooklyn Bridge Park Luxury Condominium** – If you look around the park you'll see several huge buildings surrounding the outskirts of it. Many of them like the Watch Tower next to Pier 1. There are a lot of plans in process for private funding of the park from these buildings but there is also tension from the public aspect as there might be a conflict of interest.
2. **Kid Friendly Playground and Recreation Activities** – As we walk further down Pier 6, you'll see multiple parts to a playground, a fishing area, beach volleyball courts and a dog run as well. Look at what type of people predominantly hang around there and think about how Pier 6 helps improve the social aspect of the community

Brooklyn Bridge Park is located on Brooklyn's East River Shoreline in the Brooklyn Heights and DUMBO neighborhood. The park is divided into eleven sections: Piers 1 through 6, Fulton Ferry Landing, Brooklyn Bridge Plaza, Empire Fulton Ferry, Main Street, and John Street. This Pod Walk is meant to help you learned more about Brooklyn Bridge Park and what the park strives for.

Pier 1

1. **Viewing Lawn** – Take a look at the beautiful grass and notice how families tend to spend the most time together at the viewing lawn since it's a common area for families to have picnics. The open space also makes it easy for groups to play games together.



2. **Granite Prospect** – As we approach these steps get a glimpse of the beautiful scenery in front of it. Take a moment and sit down on these steps. The steps that you're currently sitting on are made from recycled material and are also a remembrance of the old stoop.

3. **Salt Marsh** – The timber piles you see serve as landing sites for indigenous birds to dry their wings. Take a moment and try and spot as many different species as you can that are resting near the Salt Marsh

4. **EV Charging Station** – These containers that you see have solar panels on top of them that help store energy. When you walk around today take notice of the maintenance vehicles driving around. These stations charge all the vehicles.

5. **Brooklyn Ice Cream Factory** – Are you tired? Take a break and enjoy some ice cream. While you're eating your ice cream absorb the scenery around you.
